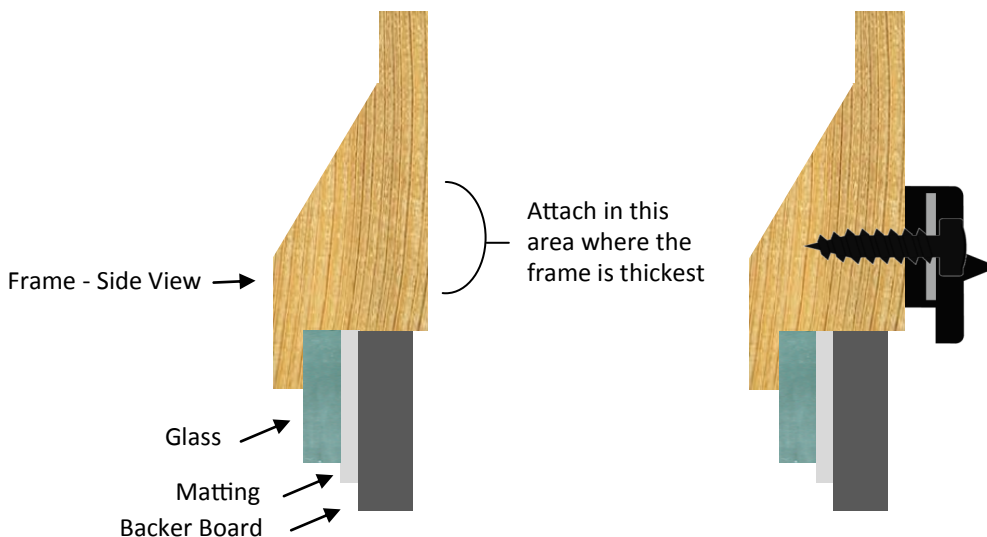
THERE IS JUST ONE REASON WHY YOU CAN ATTACH TWO ACCU-HANGER BRACKETS RANDOMLY.

The point (spike or tip) on the break-off marking tab represents the exact location where you install a nail, Atomic Anchor or screw in the wall. So you don't need to do any measuring when attaching the brackets or making sure they are perfectly level with the top of the bracket, because the fastener is always married up perfectly with the fastener. You can't screw this up, or as we say, "It's Goof Proof". They can even be twisted up to 15° and your picture will still hang perfectly straight.



Note:

Make sure your picture frame is thicker than the length of the screw to prevent it from coming out on the front side. If there's room to attach the brackets, you can hang anything within the weight limits shown on the package.
