

INTERCHANGE PICTURES BY USING A JIG CUT-OUT

Switching picture frames in and out on your walls for a different look or for different seasons or special occasions throughout the year can add a little spice to your home environment. There is a very easy way to do this using my Smart Hangers.

- (1) Make a template using a stiff flat paperboard. Make 90° cut-outs on each end. You will use this one template on all your frames. The length of the template can be of your choosing. This is a great solution for frames that are 10" wide or wider.
- (2) Next, tape your template to your frame making sure it's flush with the top edge of your frame and tape it to the frame using masking tape.
- (3) The template allows you to easily position the brackets in the cut-out corner area on each end of the template, as shown. Attach the brackets to the frame as they remain positioned in the 90° cut-out corners. Then, hang your picture using the hanging instructions.

Repeat these steps for each frame you want to interchange with others. Then you can simply take one picture down and put up a different one for each season or occasion, and it's fast, fun and easy-to-do.
